





Housing Affordability, Southern California Share of Families Afford Median Priced Home, 1988-2018









Sector Job Growth 2011-2018







Median Health Care Pay: 2018














Price Competition Highest Price Gaps In History

Home Price Advantage, Inland Empire & So. California Markets Median Priced New & Existing Home, 4th Quarter 2018
















Median Moderate Paying Real Estate, Finance, K-12 Jobs: 2018






Median Household Income, 2017 Deducting Housing Costs Above IE


Total Population (millions) Inland Empire As A State, July 2018






